Description:

The ministry of Communication seeks to invite and encourage both Longwood and Hampden-Sydney students to become involved with Catholic Campus Ministry while simultaneously connecting the organization with the world at large. As an overarching, behind-the-scenes ministry, Communications promotes and publicizes the events of the ministry as a whole, helping CCM maintain a regular, consistent, and welcoming presence through digital media. In doing so, this ministry encourages students to practice their Catholic faith and engage with fellow Catholic students on campus.

Duties:

- 1) Advertising
 - a) CCM Email
 - i) Work with staff to figure out the most important details for the weekly CCM email
 - ii) Work with staff to ensure that the contact database is up to date
 - iii) Send email promptly at the start of the week to inform the community of what is taking place
 - b) Social Media
 - i) Manage advertising for events and posting pictures from events
 - ii) Make 2-3 posts per week.
 - (1) The only posts that need to be cleared by staff are those based on morals and updates from the campus and/or diocese. If events have already been discussed and scheduled, they do not need to be cleared (though they can always be sent to staff to verify information or check grammar/spelling/presentation if desired)
 - iii) Come up with one social media campaign per semester
 - (1) Ideas include: First Day of School, Thanks CCM, Why I love CCM
 - c) Pulpit Announcements
 - i) Create announcements when necessary and submit to staff.
 - (1) Sunday Brunch, Small Group Sign Ups, Summit, etc.
 - d) Photos
 - i) Collect photos from other Leadership Team members
 - (1) Store the photos in a place to be shared with staff
- 2) Welcome Week
 - a) All Leadership Team members will participate and lead Welcome Week activities
- 3) Administration
 - a) Meetings
 - i) Attend all Leadership Team meetings unless significant circumstances intervene
 - ii) Attend Leadership Retreat
 - c) Publicity
 - i) Be sure photos are taken at events and posted to ministry media
